World Record Holder Kenneth Westerfeld to speak at the Anglers

Mark your calendars now! February 23rd we will have, Kenneth Westerfeld speaking at our meeting! Ken is the current world record holder for blackfish after landing his immense 28.08 lb blackfish last January! He has spoken in the last year at the Bayside Anglers group, the Sound Anglers of Branford Ct., the Peninsula Saltwater Anglers Association of Newport News VA., and at the NY Boat Show. Future seminars are scheduled with us, the NJ Boat show, the Rockland CTY Show, and the Somerset show in NJ.

I have spoken to him a few times and this seminar seems to be geared towards everyone! He has indicated he will be focusing on just about every aspect of blackfishing and included are topics such as inshore shallow water jigging, bait fishing on the north and south shores, deep water wreck fishing, and of course traveling to the different areas to fish such as Maryland where he landed the record tog. He likes to engage his audiences and answer questions as well as dive into boat handling, rigging, and even Reef building. He will have his portable mount of the record fish with him as well as photos. The more time we can give him to speak the more he can cover, so we ask that everyone gets to the meeting early and we can give him the floor in a timely fashion. As a reminder, this meeting is also our first open meeting of the year as we strive for new memberships so if you have any friends that fish please bring them!
